# Is your Disney+ free year expiring? Here's why you should renew your subscription

Today is the magical one-year anniversary of the Disney Plus streaming platform launch, or as Disney is referring to it, the Plusiversary. No really, you can even purchase a Plusiversary shirt to celebrate the milestone.

If you asked me one year ago if I was interested in signing up for yet another streaming service I would have said, *"I already have Netflix, Hulu, and Amazon Prime, I don't possibly need Disney Plus, too."* But boy, was I wrong...

Upon signing up for a new Verizon Unlimited plan last year, I got access to a free one-year membership to Disney+. On its launch day, I opened up the platform and went straight for the *Hannah Montana* series to relive my youth. After watching a few episodes, I explored the rest of the platform and discovered that they had so many more shows and movies that I was interested in watching. At the time, it was more than enough that the platform gave me access to every classic title from Disney and Pixar that you can think of, but since then they've added my favorite movies from Marvel, the live production of *Hamilton*, and exclusive content such as the *Star Wars* universe cult-favorite show, *The Mandalorian*. If that's not enough, they add new content every week.

Simply put, I'm hooked on Disney+ and can't go on without it. Although my free membership is done, I will continue to subscribe to the service. Whether you had a free one-year promo or your paid subscription is expiring, here's all you need to know to sign up.

## **How much is Disney+?**

It costs \$6.99 a month or \$69.99 per year for just a subscription to Disney+. Or you can get the service as part of a special value bundle with Disney+, ESPN+, and Hulu for \$12.99 a month in total.

Some Verizon mobile and FIOS customers will get a free year of Disney+ on the telecom company. Check with Verizon to see if your plan qualifies.

## What can you watch on Disney+?

The subscription-based platform is the new home for Walt Disney Studios films as well as original, exclusive Disney+ content like Lucasfilm's *Star Wars* series, *The Mandalorian*, and a full slate of live-action Marvel shows. Disney+ is also the home for original series like *High School Musical: The Musical: The Series*, a live-action *Lady and the Tramp* remake, and the upcoming Marvel series, *Wanda Vision*.

In addition to its all-new programming, Disney+ offers on-demand access to classic titles like *Fantasia*, *The Little Mermaid*, the original *High School Musical*, *Lilo & Stitch*, *The Sword in the Stone*, *Toy Story*, *Tron*, *Up*, and *Wall-E*. The extensive library also includes such beloved TV series as *Boy Meets World*, *DuckTales*, *Kim Possible*, *Marvel's Ultimate Spider-Man*, *Mickey Mouse Clubhouse*, *Star Wars: The Clone Wars*, *That's So Raven*, and 30 seasons of *The Simpsons*.

## How do you renew your Disney+ subscription?

To continue accessing all of these great features, don't fret—whether you purchased Disney+ directly or through Verizon, your annual subscription will be automatically renewed. You will receive emails warning you that your subscription is ending soon and that you will continue to be billed if you don't cancel. You can check the status of your Disney+ membership through your account settings in the top-right dropdown menu on your platform profile. Here you can find out whether your subscription is managed directly through the platform or through Verizon. If you're not interested in continuing your subscription, simply click on 'Billing Details' and from there you will be guided through a cancellation process. Additionally, there's an option to switch your subscription to The Disney Bundle, which gives you access to Hulu, Disney+, and ESPN.
