Disney+ is supported on desktop browsers, a wide range of mobile devices, smart TVs, and game consoles. The platform serves as the new home for Walt Disney Studios films as well as original, exclusive Disney+ content like Lucasfilm's Star Wars series—including *The Mandalorian* and the final season of *The Clone Wars*—and a full slate of live-action Marvel shows.
